

OCT. 1, 2020 MESSAGE FROM BEAUFORT COUNTY SCHOOLS

Effective, October 12, 2020, Beaufort County Schools will operate under Plan A for all Pre-K – 5th grade students as permitted by Governor Cooper. All Pre-K – 5th grade students are eligible to attend school, face-to-face, four days each week. Wednesday will remain a remote learning day for all students.

Students in grades 6th-12th, will attend school under Plan B as directed by Governor Cooper. This includes a mix of face-to-face (F2F) and remote learning (RL) opportunities for students and educators.

Group A students - F2F on Monday/Tuesday; RL on Wednesday/Thursday/Friday each week

Group B students - RL on Monday/Tuesday/Wednesday; F2F on Thursday/Friday each week

Group B students will return to school for their F2F instruction on October 15, 2020. (Group A will be remote learning on 10/15 & 10/16)

Group A students will return to school for their F2F instruction on October 19, 2020. (Group B will be remote learning on 10/19 & 10/20; F2F on 10/22 & 10/23)

Again, each Wednesday will remain a remote learning day for all students.

This does mean there will be varying student schedules, bus routes, bell times, etc. within Bath Elementary, Northeast Elementary, SW Snowden Elementary and Chocowinity Middle School and may impact other locations as well.

All schools will be communicating student group assignments, bus route details, bell times, and other important information to families via social media, Blackboard Connect calls, and/or other means as soon as possible.

Please remember that Wednesday October 14, 2020 is a teacher workday so no online instruction will take place that day.

Students that remain on 100% remote learning will still be able to pick up meals at various sites. More specific details will be released concerning specific locations.
