





Maximum Wind Gusts



Cape Lookout Lighthouse

Soundside Outer Banks from Rodanthe to Nags Head, Roanoke Island, and mainland Dare County:

- 1-3 ft of inundation above ground level.
- Minor coastal flooding of very low lying roads, parking lots, and properties around the northern Pamlico Sound.



Event Summary

Confidence is HIGH that strong/gusty winds and minor coastal impacts will occur, but still LOW in the potential for severe weather.



Strong Winds: Gusty winds will blow around unsecured objects and cause some tree damage. A few power outages are possible.



Severe Weather: A few strong to severe storms could bring locally enhanced wind damage.



Coastal Impacts: Minor coastal flooding along the northern Pamlico Sound and dangerous surf and beach erosion south of Cape Hatteras expected.



Very Dangerous Marine Conditions: Seas 8-12+ ft and strong Gale Force winds.
