

# Strong Coastal Low to Impact Eastern NC Sunday into Monday



## OVERVIEW

A strong low pressure system will impact Eastern NC Sunday and Monday, capable of producing strong winds, heavy rain, minor to moderate coastal flooding, and dangerous marine conditions.

## TIMING

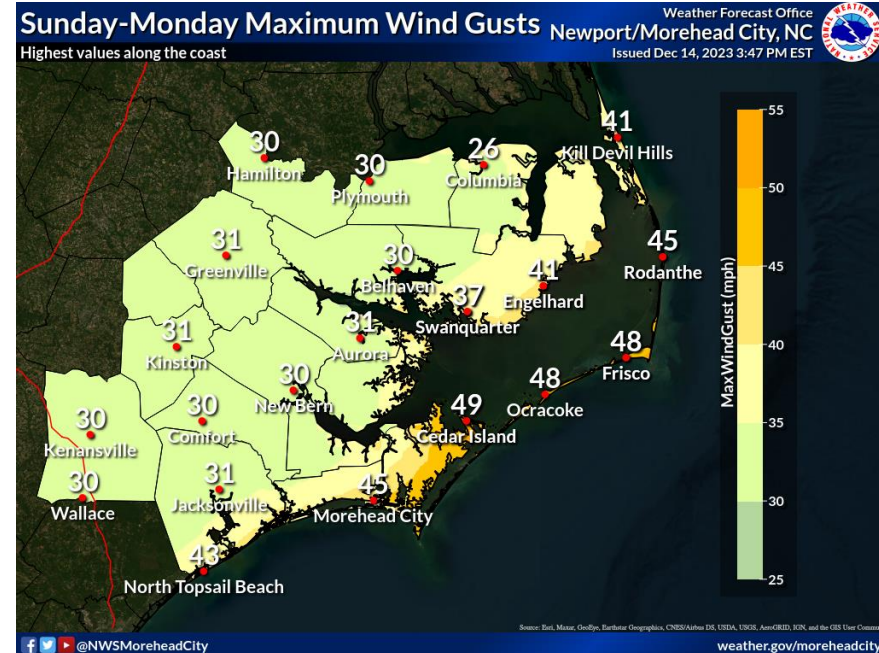
Sunday and Monday

## HAZARDS & IMPACTS

- **Strong/gusty winds** could blow around light unsecured objects such as holiday decorations and cause isolated power outages.
- **Coastal impacts:** Minor to moderate **coastal flooding** possible soundside, oceanside, and along the Pamlico and Neuse Rivers. Periods of **low water levels**, causing navigational issues, are possible for soundside OBX. Minor **ocean overwash** possible.
- **Dangerous marine conditions** with gale to storm force winds and hazardous seas will exist across all waterways.

## FORECAST CHALLENGES

- While the timing of the low and wind impacts are coming into better focus, the strength and track of the low, and thus the severe threat and area of heaviest rainfall remain moderately uncertain at this time.

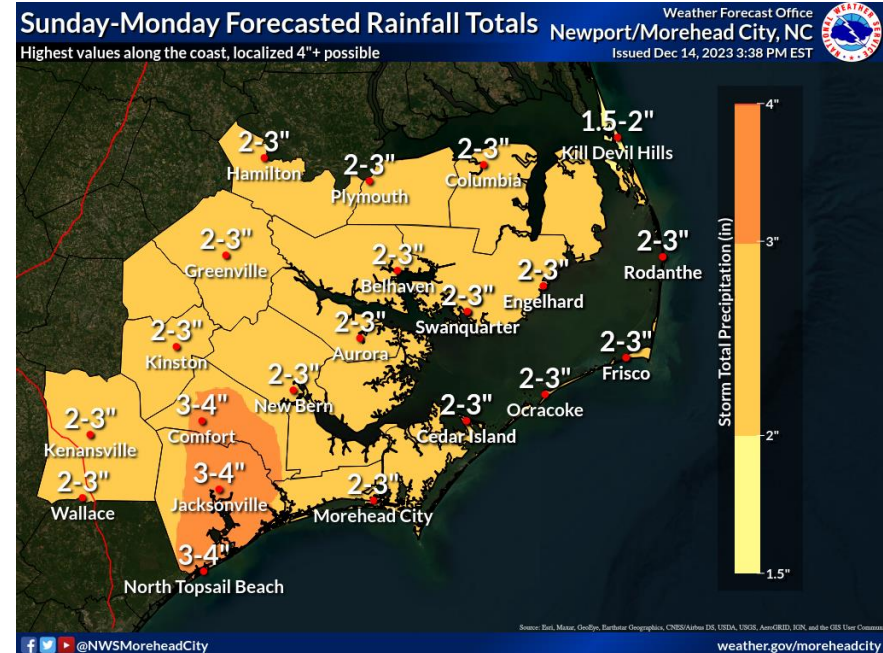

## OVERVIEW

## HAZARDS & IMPACTS

- Areas of **heavy rainfall** will bring the potential for localized **minor to moderate flooding** to poor drainage areas.
- Heaviest period of rain is expected to be **Sunday afternoon and evening.**
- Isolated rainfall totals in excess of 4" possible.
