

The highest rainfall totals are expected over inland zones. We now have a <u>Flood</u> <u>Watch in effect from 8PM tonight to 8PM</u> <u>Thursday</u>.</li> <li>Strong winds could blow around light unsecured objects and cause isolated power outages <u>Thursday</u> <u>evening into Friday morning</u>. Winds gusts 35-45 mph along the coast.</li> <li>Coastal impacts: Minor coastal flooding possible (soundside and oceanside) <u>Thursday night into Friday</u>.
