

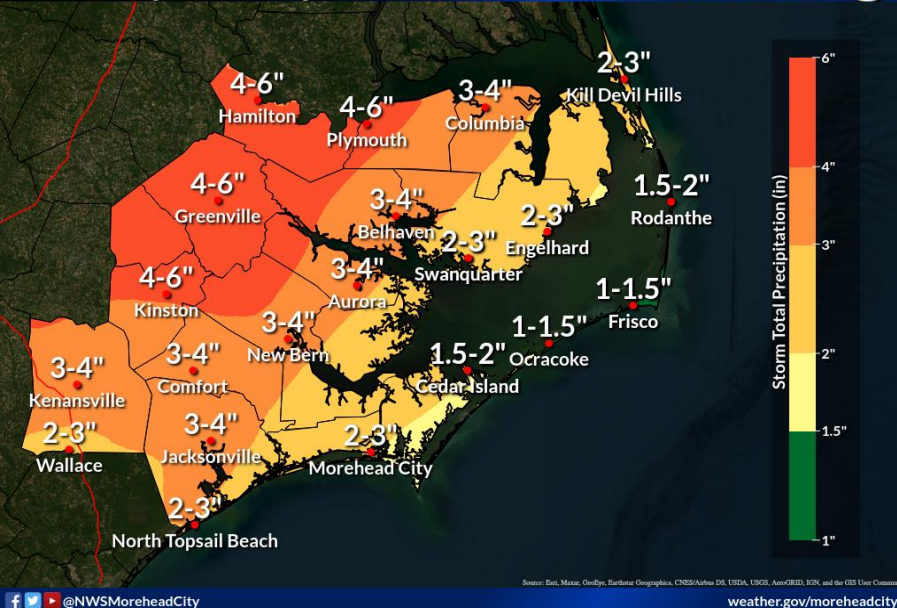
A Coastal Low Will Impact Eastern NC Wednesday To Friday



OVERVIEW

A coastal low will impact Eastern NC tonight into Friday morning bringing the potential for **heavy rain, strong winds, minor coastal flooding, and dangerous marine conditions.**

TIMING

- Wednesday Night To Friday morning.

HAZARDS & IMPACTS

- **Widespread moderate to heavy rainfall** leading to accumulations of 2-5 inches across the area with locally higher amounts possible, this will bring the potential for localized minor flooding to poor drainage areas. The highest rainfall totals are expected over inland zones. We now have a **Flood Watch in effect from 8PM tonight to 8PM Thursday.**
- **Strong winds** could blow around light unsecured objects and cause isolated power outages Thursday evening into Friday morning. Winds gusts 35-45 mph along the coast.
- **Coastal impacts:** Minor coastal flooding possible (soundside and oceanside) Thursday night into Friday. Localized ocean overwash for vulnerable dune structures and rough surf.
- **Dangerous marine conditions** expected across all waterways.

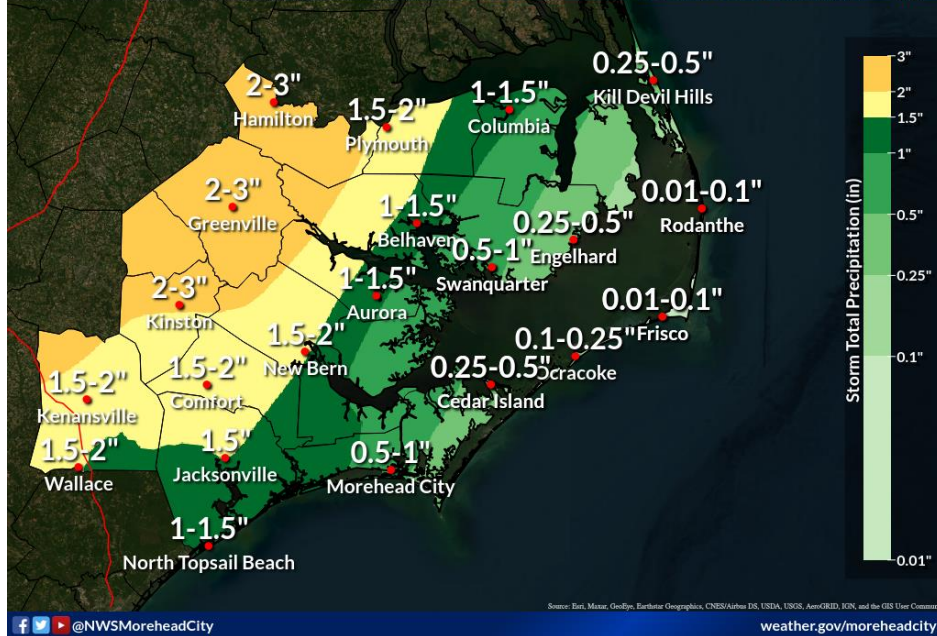

Totals Over the Period from Wednesday 8:00PM - Thursday 8:00AM

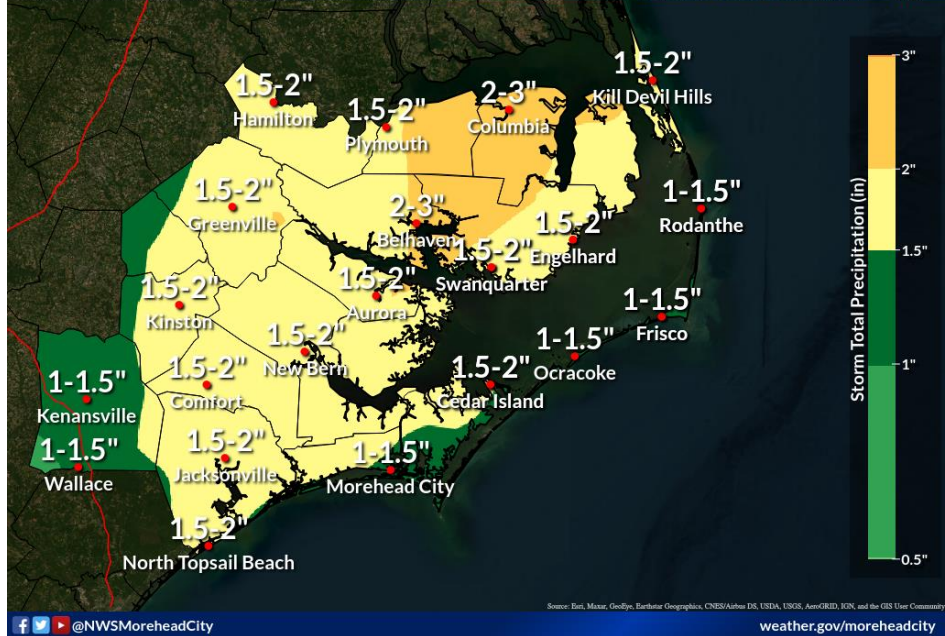
