

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
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Minor Coastal Flooding Thursday Evening into Friday



OVERVIEW

King Tides may keep water levels elevated through tonight which could result in minor nuisance coastal flooding. Better chances for minor coastal flooding expected Thursday evening into Friday.

Minor inundation (1-2 ft AGL) likely Thursday evening into Friday.

Oceanside – Greatest threat from Oregon Inlet to North Topsail Beach. Including Ocracoke Island (which could impact travel on NC-12 and ferry services).

Soundside – Areas adjacent to the northern Pamlico Sound, the Pungo River, as well as the Outer Banks from Duck to Avon.

- In addition: rough surf, localized beach erosion and strong rip currents.
- Dangerous marine conditions expected. Gale Watches have been upgraded to Warnings and expanded to all coastal waters, sounds, and inland large rivers.
