

Severe Thunderstorms Possible Today



OVERVIEW

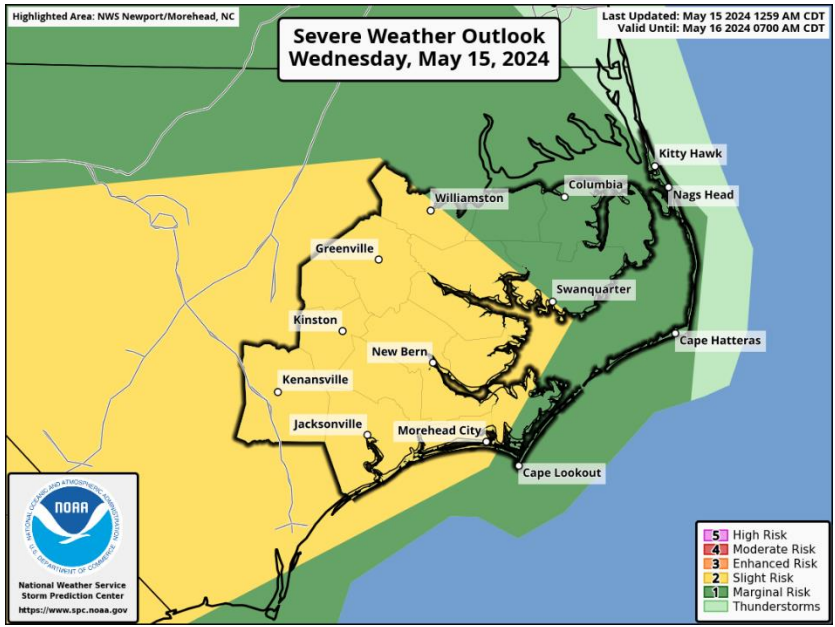
- There is a Slight (Level 2 of 5) risk of severe thunderstorms this afternoon and evening across the coastal plain, and a Marginal Risk (Level 1 of 5) along the Outer Banks and Albemarle Sound.
- The primary hazards are damaging winds and hail.

TIMING

- As early as 1-2 pm through 10-11 pm, with the highest risk in the late afternoon to early evening.

HAZARDS & IMPACTS

- Damaging wind gusts up to 60 mph and hail up to quarter-sized. Marginal tornado risk west of Highway 17.
