

Severe Weather Threat Today



OVERVIEW

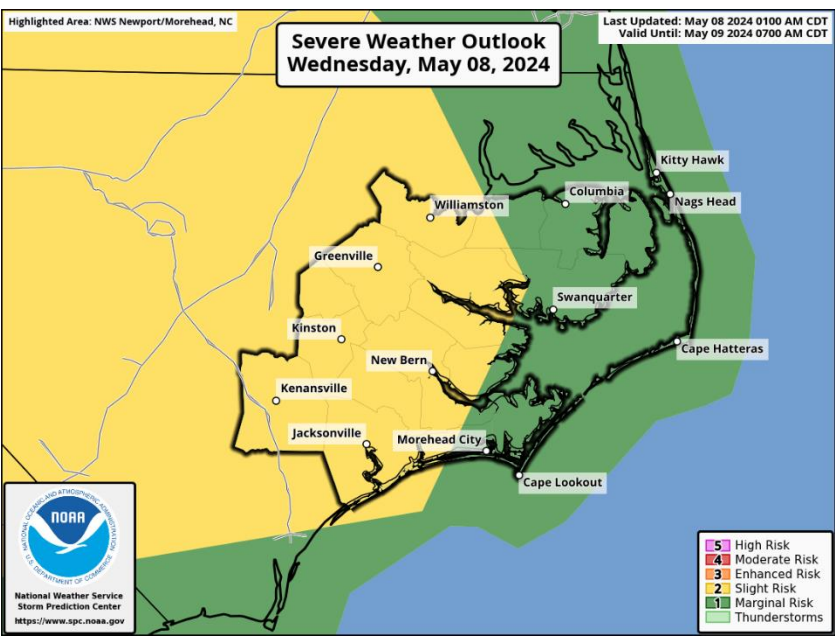
- There is potential for multiple rounds of storms, any of which could become strong to severe
- Uncertainty remains in the exact location of storms later this afternoon and evening

TIMING

- The confidence in thunderstorm development is highest in the 2 PM Wed – 12 AM Thurs timeframe

HAZARDS & IMPACTS

- There is a threat for severe weather across all of ENC, especially west of Highway 17, with strong wind gusts (50-70 mph), isolated large hail (up to golf ball size), and an isolated tornado possible in the strongest storms



ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

THUNDERSTORM WATCH

A Severe Thunderstorm Watch is issued when **a severe thunderstorm is possible**.

Stay tuned to forecast updates, monitor sky conditions, and know where to take shelter.

Be Prepared.



THUNDERSTORM WARNING

A Severe Thunderstorm Warning is issued when **a severe thunderstorm is happening or about to happen**.

Take shelter immediately!

OVERVIEW

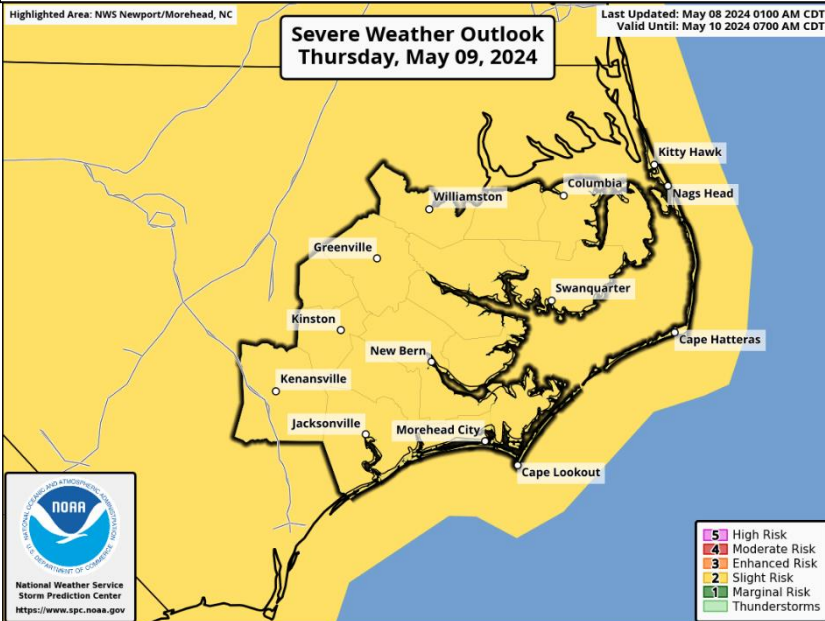
- Showers and thunderstorms are forecast to develop through the day with any storm having the potential to become strong to severe
- There is some uncertainty with overall coverage and specific timing of storms on Thursday

TIMING

- The confidence in thunderstorm development is highest in the 2 PM – 10 PM timeframe.

HAZARDS & IMPACTS

- There is a threat for severe weather across all of ENC with strong wind gusts (50-70 mph) and isolated large hail (up to quarter size) possible in the strongest storms.
